

- International network of excellence among students and UNITECH Alumni, companies and universities












UNITECH Programme Overview



After graduation:

- Assessment Centre here in INSA Lyon on February 11, 2016







Application Form

You will be asked to fill in the following UNITECH Questionnaire sections:

- Essay questions
- Study plans for each of your three target universities (3 separate study plans), <u>based on your</u> study plan and on the guidelines of each host university (courses/programme available, minimum number of credits, language requirements etc...)

You will also be asked to upload the following documents:

- your Curriculum Vitae (PDF)
- a passport-size picture (JPG) [Not a copy of your passport!]
- your Transcript of Records (PDF) you can use the self-certified version in Italian available on your online services – <u>You have to sign the document before uploading it</u>

In addition to this, you may upload any documents you wish to add or that are required by your target universities (please see respective university information) such as

- language certificates
- recommendation letters.

Please make sure the attachments do not exceed the maximum file size as specified in the application form. UNITECH: A network of professional possibilities
